

Pig Cake

1 box butter cake mix (yellow)
1 small can mandarin oranges, with juice
½ cup oil (I use Canola oil)
4 eggs
½ cup coconut (more, if desired)

Mix all ingredients together thoroughly.
Pour into 3 layer-cake pans that have been greased and floured.
Bake at 325 degrees for 25 minutes (no longer).

Topping:

2 small boxes instant vanilla pudding mix
1 medium can crushed pineapple with juice
2 9-oz, containers Cool Whip

Mix pudding, pineapple, and Cool Whip together until pudding granules are dissolved (I usually combine the three ingredients, let the mixture rest a few minutes, then stir again—seems to dissolve the pudding granules better and faster that way).

Spread between layers. Cover and refrigerate until well-chilled, at least 24 hours before serving; return remainder of cake to refrigerator.
